**Abstract**

The Director and staff of the NYS Water Resources institute carry out numerous public service activities each year. Most of them are done in conjunction with multidisciplinary projects funded outside of the Water Resources Research Act context. In order to cross-link the WRRRA activities in this program to many other NYS WRI activities, a small portion of WRRRA resources are devoted to information transfer and student training functions.

The primary objective of this activity is to maintain rapport with State agencies and key constituencies in environmental, water supply, agricultural, and other business sectors. A secondary objective is to involve Cornell University students in public service projects with local and State government.

Most interaction with committees is done via meetings, telephone calls, and electronic mail exchanges.

Student projects are typically connected to large NYS WRI projects with the same agencies or in the same geographic locales.
