

A New Series for the “National Field Manual for the Collection of Water-Quality Data”

The “National Field Manual for the Collection of Water-Quality Data” (NFM) is published by the U.S. Geological Survey (USGS). The NFM is prepared specifically for USGS field personnel.

Before 2017, NFM chapters were released in the USGS Techniques of Water-Resources Investigations (TWRI) series. Effective in 2017, new and revised NFM chapters are being released in the USGS Techniques and Methods series, which was established in 2003 to replace the TWRI series and other USGS reports. The change in the series classification does not in itself affect the content and format of the NFM.

Each chapter of the NFM is reviewed regularly and revised periodically to update procedures, incorporate technical advances, and to address additional emerging topics of relevance to water-quality field studies. The NFM home page contains the latest version of each chapter; information on the purpose, scope, and revisions; and “Comments and Errata” pages that chronicle comments and changes.
