Subject: Training – Update on FY 2012 Registration for Water-Quality Principles (QW1022-TEL)

Water-Quality Principles (QW1022-TEL) has been removed temporarily from the DOI Learn course catalog. Enrollment in the January rollout of Water-Quality Principles (QW1022-TEL) far exceeded the ten-to-one student-instructor ratio required for this instructor-facilitated online course. Since DOI Learn does not have the facility to announce when an online (User-Defined Training or “UDT”) course reaches capacity, registrations were allowed to continue beyond the 20-student limitation for this offering. As a result, the course will be offered a second time in FY 2012 and will first accommodate those registrants who did not make the cut-off for the January offering. If you are among those who registered for the course already, please be assured that your space is saved for the next course offering; you need not register again. The next FY2012 course date will be announced in the near future, in addition to when the course will be reopened for registration in DOI Learn.

While we are pleased to report on the overwhelming demand for this course, we regret any inconvenience and disappointment that the faulty registration process may have caused and we will work to rectify that situation.
