

User Guide for Institute Role in IPETT

Creating an IPETT account:

- Go to <https://my.usgs.gov/resources/> and select "Sign Up" Under Identity Management at the bottom of the page

myUSGS

myUSGS offers a suite of access-controlled online information management and collaboration tools, ideal for use by USGS scientists and their research teams and external partners. This toolset consists of a growing set of public Web sites that share content from within this integrated information environment as well as a wide variety of online intranet/extranet communities. USGS users may log on to this system using their Active Directory credentials, while users from outside USGS may request an account from the login page below.

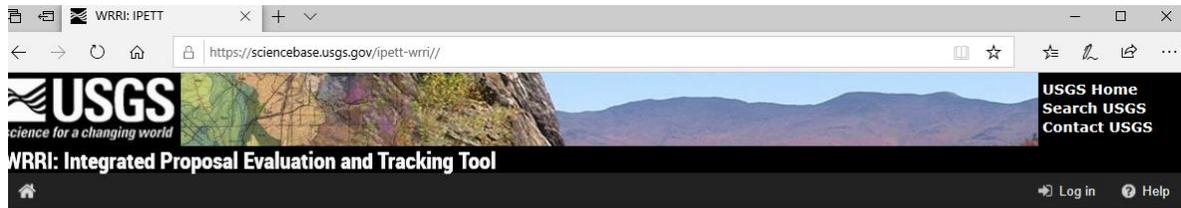

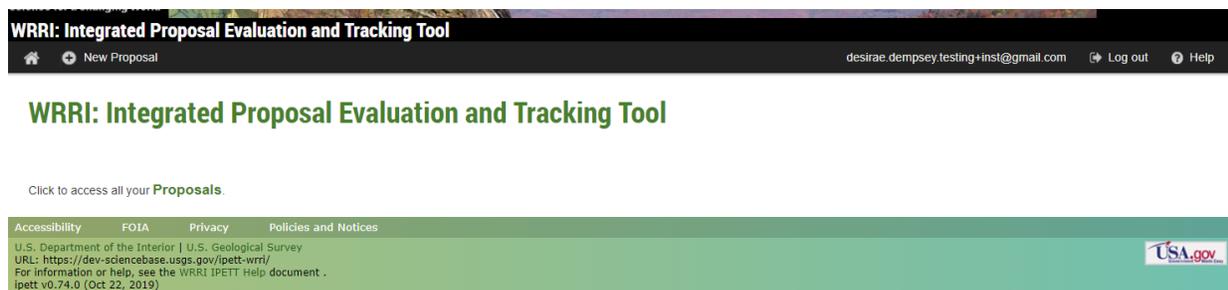


WRI: Integrated Proposal Evaluation and Tracking Tool

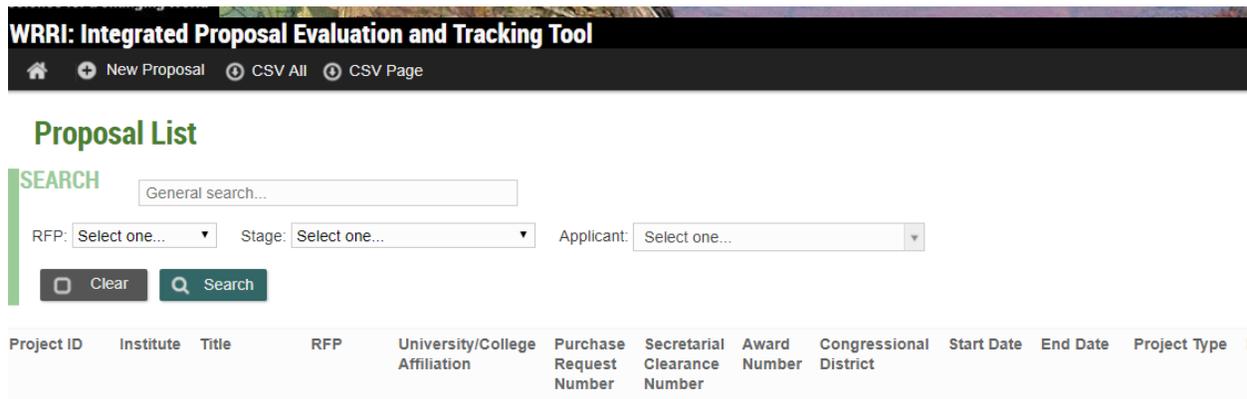
Please log in.



- Select log in and this should be the screen you see as an Institute:



- You should be able to see options to “access all your Proposals” and “+ New Proposals”
- Click “Access all your Proposals” to see all proposals created under your Institute
 - This list will show all proposals for all 4 grant types
 - There is the ability to filter by RFP, Stage, and Applicant and a general search
 - A CSV of all the proposals under your Institute can be downloaded or a CSV of the page you are currently on
 - Occasionally you will see the page reload, this is the tool refreshing to make sure it is up to date



Creating a new Proposal:

- Click “+ New Proposal” to create a new proposal
- Please choose which RFP the proposal belongs to first, the fields reset to match which RFP is selected

- 1. Once the RFP has been chosen fill in the fields with as much information that is currently available about the proposal
- Attach any documents related to the proposal such as the Proposal, Budget documents, and any Letters in support of the proposal
- 2. IF all proposal documents are in a zip file it can be imported into the tool – select “Choose File” to select the correct zip file – once selected hit “Create” at the bottom of the page – several fields will be ingested into the tool as well as the documents in the zip file

- After all information and documents have been attached to the proposal hit “Create” at the bottom of the screen

- This will create the proposal under the RFP you selected. A **Project ID** will be created and will be the ID for the proposal going forward

- Once ALL the proposal information required in the RFP and the necessary documents have been added to the proposal select “Accept Proposal”
- This moves the proposal forward and helps Earl know you are done with the proposal and we are ready to move on with the RFP
- This completes the Institute role in the IPETT tool

Submission to Grants.gov:

- After the proposals have been created in IPETT you have the ability to download the proposal

- This download turns into a zip file and will include the Proposal fields collected in the IPETT tool as well as any documents uploaded to the proposal in IPETT – if all the fields are filled out and necessary documents have been attached this zip file has everything needed to be submitted to Grants.gov

Additional Help:

- If a new person (such as a PI or a new Institute Contact) needs to be added to the IPETT tool email ddempsey@usgs.gov with the name and email of the new user and we will work with them to get access to the tool
- If proposal information needs to be changed at later stages in the RFP email ddempsey@usgs.gov or eagreene@usgs.gov to correct proposal information
- RFPs will be created when the funding has been approved by DOI – Earl's team will send a notification when the RFP is open for submissions
- The SF-424 is **not** required for submission in the IPETT tool however it **IS** a requirement for submission through <https://www.grants.gov/web/grants>
